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Re: Conclusion of the National Council for the National Assembly and Emergency Preparedness on the topic: "Mental First Aid Model"

We hereby confirm that on June 6, 2017, the Supreme Council for Mental Health in Israel, headed by Prof. Avi Bleich, convened to discuss and choose a national model for providing Psychological First Aid.

The committee chose the "Ma'ase" model (generic name: SIX C's Model), developed by Dr. Moshe Farchi, as the suitable, nonprofessional model for initial Psychological First Aid interventions on the field of the event. The model was also found to be suitable for interventions in case of immediate secondary traumatization (The helper's trauma).

Accordingly, various populations in Israel like first responders, authorities, government ministries, educational institutions, etc will be trained for using the Ma'ase model (SIX C's Model) as the basic model for providing Psychological first aid.
